Assistance available for International Students

- *Academic Merit Scholarships* - Renewable annual scholarships are available for incoming Freshman (\$6,000 - \$10,000 per year) and incoming transfer students (\$4,000 - \$6,000). These are awarded based on ACT/SAT scores (Freshman only) and transcripts. Please email for more details.
- *Athletic Scholarships* - These are awarded by individual coaches (soccer, volleyball, basketball, baseball, softball and cross-country).
- *Art and Music Scholarships* - Students majoring in Art may submit a digital portfolio of their work for consideration. All students are eligible to audition for a music scholarship. Please email for more details.
- *On-Campus Employment* - F-1 students are eligible to work on campus up to 20 hours per week during the school year and full-time during school breaks. Students can expect to earn between \$1,000 and \$3,000 per year, depending on the number of hours worked.
- *Cultural Ambassador Grant* - Aid for students from diverse cultural backgrounds.
- *Other Grants & Scholarships* - There are some grants available for students from specific countries or in specific areas of study.
