ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR

Tom McCoy '82

Tom McCoy graduated from Judson College in 1982 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Administration, where he also developed a passion for history and music studies. Tom is a seasoned financial advisor with M&E Catalyst Group, whose career began on July 8, 1982.

Tom's commitment to excellence is evident in his long-standing membership with the Million Dollar Round Table (MDRT), where he has been a Life and



Qualifying Member for 31 years. He currently serves as a Global Council Member of Program General Arrangements for MDRT and has held various leadership positions within the organization. His involvement with the MDRT Foundation is particularly noteworthy; he has served as a Past Trustee, Inner Circle Member, and Excalibur Knight. Additionally, he successfully secured an MDRT grant that funded the construction of eight homes in the Philippines through Habitat for Humanity after Typhoon Yolanda, showcasing his commitment to global humanitarian efforts.
